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## APPLICANT TO NOTE:

1. Applicant must be a Singaporean or Singapore Permanent Resident. One copy (front and back) of the NRIC / Birth Certificate of the applicant and family members staying in the household must be attached with the application.
2. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) is only open to staff and members of the respective self-help group / association / institution / organisation.
3. Applicant must have a good academic record, a good command of English and meet the entry requirements of the specific Bachelor's Degree programmes as stipulated by the awarding university.
4. Applicant is strongly advised to apply for a programme that best suit his / her highest attained qualifications.
5. Applicant must not possess or currently pursuing an existing graduate / undergraduate qualification. Existing MDIS students are not eligible to apply for the MDIS Scholarship (Degree).
6. Applicant must complete the MDIS application form, substantiated with all academic qualifications including two passport sized photographs. These shall be submitted and endorsed by the respective self-help group / association / institution / organisation.
7. **Definition of Total Net Monthly Family Income**
  - Excludes employee's CPF contributions
  - Includes income contributions from self-employment, business or salaried employment which include basic salary, allowances, overtime pay and other sources of income such as rent, alimony, pension, etc.
  - The monthly financial support from divorced/separated parent or spouse such as alimony and contributions to support children/household should be included.
  - National Service (NS) allowance earned by NSF is excluded.
8. **Per Capita Income (PCI)\*\*** =  $\frac{\text{Total Net Monthly Income of ALL family members}}{\text{Number of family members in the household}}$
9. **Immediate and non-immediate family members**
  - Immediate family members include parents and siblings living together with the applicant.
  - Divorced/separated parent or spouse may be excluded from the headcount.
  - Non-immediate family members include grandparents, siblings' spouses, siblings' children and any other relatives who are living together with the applicant (bearing the same address as the applicant's NRIC).
10. The total net monthly family income must not exceed S\$4,000 per month and S\$800 PCI (excluding CPF), whichever is lower.
11. Each MDIS Scholarship (Degree) will provide for the following:
  - a. Tuition fee up to a maximum of \$25,000 (excluding non-tuition fee, supplementary exam fee and re-module fee)
  - b. Waiver of application fee
12. Approved MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient is required to pay the MDIS membership entrance and subscription fee.

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13. Approved MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient is not allowed to change to another course once the University has successfully approved the application. The scholarship is non-transferable and non-exchangeable for cash.
14. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient will be offered the next available intake of the programme after the awards ceremony. In the event that the recipient is not able to join that intake, a written notification must be submitted to MDIS for approval to defer commencement of the programme to the following intake.
15. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient must commence his / her programme before the awards ceremony of the following year, failing which the MDIS Scholarship (Degree) will be forfeited.
16. Each MDIS Scholarship (Degree) is tenable for the minimum period required by the recipient to complete his / her course of study.
17. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient shall not concurrently hold any other scholarships or other awards without the prior approval of MDIS. Any applicant who is holding other scholarships and awards shall declare so in the application form.
18. No service of bond or contract is required for the MDIS Scholarship (Degree).
19. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient must meet any other specified terms and conditions of the respective self-help group / association / institution / organisation.
20. The MDIS Selection Committee reserves the right to terminate the MDIS Scholarship (Degree) of the recipient, based on unsatisfactory conduct and attendance in class, or for any other valid reasons. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient will repay the course fee if they fail the examinations leading to the award of the programme.
21. The MDIS Scholarship (Degree) recipient is required to appear in any publicity pertaining to the MDIS Scholarship (Degree) award. Any form of publicity to the MDIS Scholarship (Degree) award will be at the discretion of MDIS.
